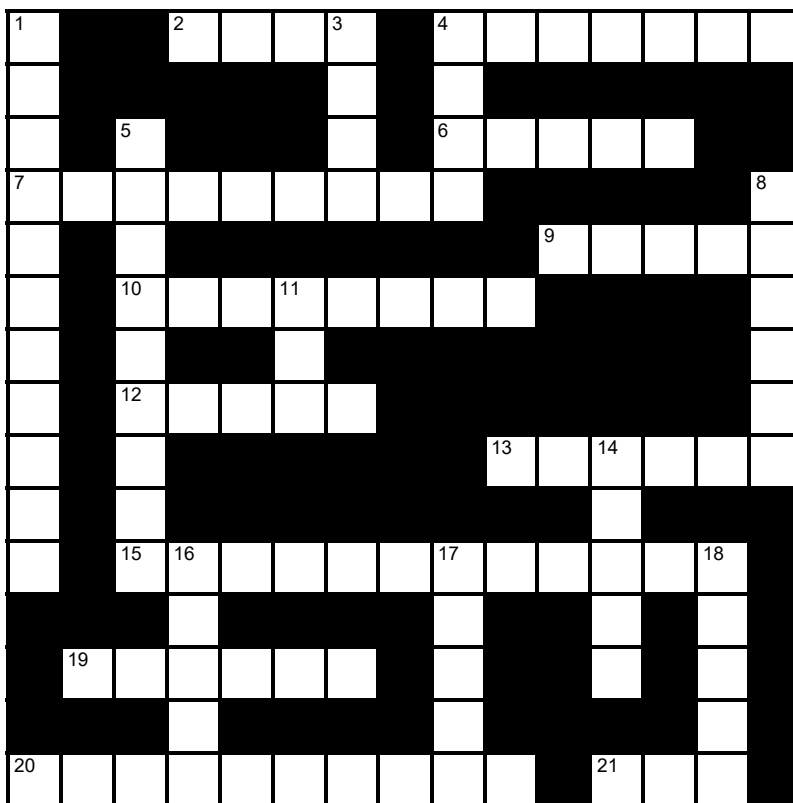


Across

- 2 How you place your hands and hold a club
- 4 The area of the course where the grass is cut short between the tee and the green
- 6 A place where golfers can practice hitting balls
- 7 Correct behavior and courtesy on the golf course
- 9 A chunk of grass and dirt taken out of the ground by the golf club during a swing



- 10 A short low shot that you want to land on the green and roll toward the hole
- 12 The number of strokes (swings made and penalty strokes) taken on a hole
- 13 When you swing at the ball and try to hit it, you have made a stroke
- 15 The area of the course where you hit your first shot on a hole
- 19 A hole where the fairway bends around a corner
- 20 A designated area in which non-playing participants

- must stand in order to ensure a safe environment, usually 5 yds on the non-target side of the playing participants
- 21 The spot where the ball is sitting
- about to hit the ball or have hit a ball that is headed toward them
- 5 A high shot played to the putting green, having little or no roll
- 8 The position of the feet when you are getting ready to hit the ball
- 11 The number of strokes a professional or elite *PLAYer* would be expected to make on a hole
- 14 An area of long grass around the teeing ground,
- fairways and greens
- 16 A score in golf that is two strokes under par on a hole
- 17 The area of the course where a hole ends and the grass is cut the shortest
- 18 A long shot played from the teeing ground

- 1 A body of water on the golf course that is marked by red stakes
- 3 A shot played on the green in which you try to roll the ball to the hole
- 4 A warning shouted to alert other players that you are
